Organized within the EU-funded project “co:op”, this workshop will specifically highlight those copyright issues that arise during archiving and provision of protected cultural property. #### Directions for individuals

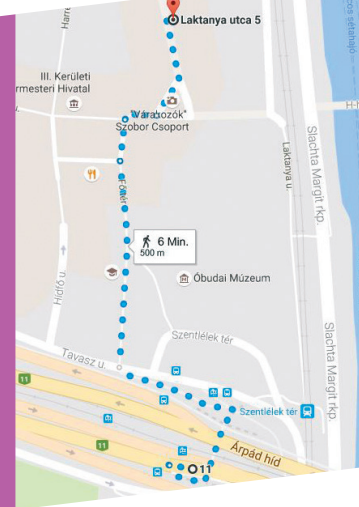
- From **IBIS** take M3 from "Kálvin tér" to the "Deák tér" (2 stops) and change the M2 to "Kossuth tér" (one stop)
- From the **Hotel Ring** it is within walking distance (10 minutes through Nagy Ignác u. and Szalay utca)
- From the **City Hotel Mátyás** take the tram Nr. 2 (direction: "Jászai Mari tér") and get off at "Országház Látogatóközpont"

### How to get to the National Archives of Hungary?

Take the M2 metro to "Széll Kálmán tér" stop, then change to bus Nr. 16 or Nr. 16A and get off at the second stop.

## Obuda Trófea Grill Restaurant

Either come to the meeting point BFL Aula at 19.30 o'clock or take the tram Nr. (direction Bécsi út/Vörösvári út) from Árpád híd M3 Station to Szentlélek tér (2 stops). From there it is a 5 minute walk to the restaurant.
