1. UPCOMING EVENTS:

"Das transparente Archiv - Verborgenes Wissen elektronisch nutzen": presentation of the Vienna City Archives (Wiener Stadt- und Landesarchiv, AT), 11th March 2010, 17:00

On the 11th of March, beginning at 5 p.m., the Vienna City Archives will present their latest innovations in the field of online presentation, databases and information systems for archives. The agenda includes the following main topics:

- WAIS (= Wiener ArchivInformationsSystem) an online database of archival documents concerning city and communal administration from the middle Ages until today.
- INFODAT a database of documents from the city council and parliament- offering the opportunity of a more detailed insight into the work of the politicians in Vienna.
- MONASTERIUM.NET the online charters portal now holds about 10.000 Viennese charters.

Following the presentations, the Vienna City Archives offer a nocturnal guided tour through its premises, starting at 7 p.m.

New common website for catholic archives in Germany: www.katholische-archive.de

The new website <u>www.katholische-archive.de</u> contains all relevant information about catholic archives in Germany, including historical background, overviews of the archives' holdings, general organisational and judicial regulations for German catholic archives, etc.

Monasterium.Net: new charters online

Within the last few months several new stocks of charters were integrated into the Monasterium-portal:

- Bistumsarchiv Hildesheim (DE): ca. 250 charters (monastery of St. Michael)
- Wiener Stadt- und Landesarchiv (AT): ca. 10.000 charters
- Stadtarchiv Bregenz (AT): ca.1500 charters
- Státní oblastní archív Třeboň (CZ): ca. 3000 charters
- Plzeň, Státní oblastní archiv (CZ): ca. 1000 charters (Klaster Teplá)
- Moravský zemský archiv v Brně (CZ): ca. 600 charters (several Southern Moravian monasteries, e.g. Rajhrad)

In addition to charters, ICARUS also provides online-access to digitised church records. These sources can be found on the website www.matricula-online.eu along with other helpful information, links and services, including a newly established phone hotline to support the research (the hotline will be initiated on the 1st of April 2010)
