1. Next steps in the application process – what to expect

The project application was submitted in accordance with the deadline given by the EU. The evaluation process will last until spring 2013 – first results may be expected in February/March 2013. ICARUS will inform all partners immediately of any news concerning the application.

2. Possible further cooperation of the project partners independent of the approval of the project application:

In most of the participating countries different activities dealing with WWI will be initiated apart from our common EU-project. In some cases - like in Hungary with the "National Culture Fund" - additional financial support could be gained on national level but even apart from that some activities intended to be carried out within the project could be initiated also by using other resources (own funds, other project budgets, etc.), such as:

- Building up an **information website** to share the different activities carried out by the partners and promote them towards a wider public. ICARUS will set up the basic features of the website until spring 2013 using the domain-name www.worldwar1.eu. Vlatka Lemić, Csaba Reisz and Sloboban Mandić agreed to work on the design and layout of the website and present a first version at the next ICARUS-meeting.

Each participating country will then nominate a responsible person to implement information, links, news, events etc. of the respective country into the website and administer the information on a continuous basis.

- **Conference/event in Sarajevo in 2014** to commemorate the assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand and the beginning of WWI: Vlatka Lemić already is in contact with the colleagues in Sarajevo on this behalf.
- Furthermore **other thematic conferences/workshops** as well as a **support for the mobility of experts for research purposes** are also possible within the frame and runtime of the current EU-culture project "ENArC" (lasts until April 2015)
