

Report of the Didactics workshop *MOM-CA Tools – The current state*
(Madrid, November 25, 2013, 15:30 –17:00)

The Didactics group in collaboration with Monasterium - Technical Development organised a hands-on workshop with the Cologne developers of MOM-CA, open to all participants of the ICARUS Meeting. After a brief welcome by Antonella Ambrosio there was a introduction of the developers' work by Georg Vogeler (University of Graz). Then Jochen Graf (University of Cologne) described the techniques to create a Digital Cartulary with MOM-CA (in other words, a collection) and André Streicher informed on the image tools of Monasterium which allow the user to create annotations and collections of images or image cuttings (both University of Cologne).

In the following testing phase, the participants (Antonella Ambrosio, Maria Rosaria Falcone, Przemysław Wiszewski, Maria do Rosário Morujão, Ana Garić, Kathrin Pindl, Laura Giambastiani, Annantonia Martorano, Beatrice Romiti, Daniela Di Pinto, Tillmann Lohse, Tommaso Maria Rossi, Sébastien Barret, Nina Gagova, Vesko Gluščević, Gerhard Immler, Georg Vogeler, Maria Magdalena Rueckert) had the opportunity to go through the mentioned procedures and to evaluate their utility for teaching, but also for research and for palaeography in general. There was a vivid discussion and the developers received numerous feedback on the tools.
